<u>Searches update</u> (Brill) Assistant Professor Teri Finneman of South Dakota State University will join the School in fall 2018 as Assistant Professor of broadcast multimedia. Also joining in fall 2018 will be Patricia Gaston as Professor of the Practice and Lacy C. Haynes Professor. Gaston is a Pulitzer Prizewinning journalist and Washington Post editor. The faculty search is officially closed and the committee will meet to pursue options for the unfilled position of Strategic Communications Professor of the Practice.

<u>Cultural Assessment follow-up</u> (Erba) Joseph Erba reported the cultural assessment committee met and pursued options. The assessment is officially closed. Erba transcribed the notes and organized them by these themes: faculty, faculty/staff and school wide.

The committee will receive ideas and determine the best methods to incorporate them into the assessment. Themes will be developed and the committee will be open to discussion. The committee will want to know what format will cause faculty and staff to want to come to meetings and discussions. The use of Q-sort was suggested.
